<p>6-15 months</p> <p>Carer attends</p> <p>Our 6-15 months classes introduce young babies to music. The songs and activities can be integrated into daily routines at home. Babies take part in simple movement and peek-a-boo activities. Lap plays and bouncing rhymes help babies experience a steady beat and changes in pitch. Props and puppets help capture babies' attention. Classes focus on reinforcing the special bond between baby and carer as they discover the magic of music together.</p> <p><i>i think music is fun!</i></p>	<p>1-2 year olds</p> <p>Carer attends</p> <p>The 1-2 year old classes expose toddlers to a wide range of musical experiences. Simple action songs help develop children's gross motor skills, and dances and lap plays reinforce a steady beat. Percussion instruments are used in stop-and-start activities to foster listening skills. Simple songs and rhymes are included to encourage language and speech development. The best music educators for young children are their primary caregivers. These classes will help you fulfil this important role.</p> <p><i>i make music through play</i></p>	<p>2-3 year olds</p> <p>Carer attends</p> <p>Our 2-3 year old classes focus on developing social skills and confidence as well as introducing new musical elements such as rhythm and beat. Children are encouraged to participate in group activities including games, dancing and playing percussion instruments. We use puppets and various props to stimulate the children's imaginations.</p>	<p>3-4 year olds</p> <p>Carer may attend</p> <p>In 3-4 year old classes, children start to recognise musical elements that they have experienced previously. They continue to experiment with singing, moving and playing instruments, and become familiar with musical terms through stimulating games and visual reinforcement. These classes are more structured. Children practise new skills such as one-to-one correspondence and left-to-right reading which help prepare them for kinder and school.</p> <p><i>i'm reading and playing music</i></p>	<p>4-5 year olds</p> <p>Child attends alone</p> <p>In our 4-5 year old classes, children's awareness of musical concepts becomes more evident as they start to apply their new skills to instruments such as chime bars. They begin to learn simple notation and also practise basic sight-singing techniques. Children are regularly provided with opportunities to boost their confidence and independence.</p> <p><i>i am a Mini Maestros musician</i></p>



What to expect in class

Music provides rich and abundant learning opportunities for children. The more a child is exposed to music, the more they will learn.

Each Mini Maestros class builds on the previous one to develop a strong musical foundation for every child.



Your role

The participation of parents and primary caregivers in Mini Maestros' classes is integral to the success of the program. Since children learn by imitation, they will gain confidence and inspiration from watching you sing and join in the activities.

Your role doesn't stop at the end of class. At-home follow-up activities are encouraged to help reinforce concepts learned in class.
