I spent many months following the circus from town to town, a couple of years documenting comedians on stage and back stage, 50's rock 'n' rollers, six months at Odyssey House documenting drug and alcohol rehabilitation to name a few.

I like to get to know the subjects I'm documenting, ultimately it makes the photographic portraits more interesting. Somebody once said "to be a good wild life photographer you have to be willing to take a few more steps and wait longer than the others". I like to think I have applied that philosophy to my own documentary and portrait work. The images upstairs are a very small part of the last twenty years worth of work. A couple of circus people, a couple of sculptors etc, etc.
