Notarial certificate is bound to copy of document

An apostille is bound to the notarial certificate by DFAT¹

A legalisation certificate is bound to the notarial certificate by DFAT¹







An authentication certificate is bound to the notarial & DFAT¹ certificates by a consulate or embassy
