How do I log in?

Australian Sailing (AS) has recently moved to a new system meaning your old login details will no longer work. AS numbers as usernames are no longer used.

I know my new log in details

If you know your new username, go to the left of the page on https://www.sailing.org.au/login/ and enter it and your Password, to access your mySailor profile.

I do not know my log in details?

Australian Sailing has recently moved to a new system meaning your old login details will no longer work.

If you do not know your login credentials, click on Forgot login details. Then type your email address in the space provided and click on submit to receive your login details via email. Please check your spam folder for the email. This email should arrive within a short space of time.

There may be a chance that AS don't have an email address for you or the email is wrong in their system. In this case you will not receive an email by clicking **Forgot login details** (within a short space of time). In this case, please submit the form in **UPDATE MY DETAILS** and AS will update your information and send you new login details.

Why use mySailor?

Your mySailor profile allows you to view and manage the information Australian Sailing has about you, including;

- Basic details name, DOB, gender
- Contact details email, mobile number, address
- Membership history
- Course and Qualification history

Troubleshooting

If your Australian Sailing Number is **INACTIVE** you need to reactivate your Australian Sailing Number by clicking below. **RENEW MY AUSTRALIAN SAILING NUMBER**
