<i>Jokers Peak Vineyard is situated on the slopes of Mt Canobolas at elevations of 750 – 800 mtrs. From the excellent 2008 vintage, this wine is rich and soft with fine grain tannins, interwoven with a touch of French oak.</i>	
<b>Brygon Reserve Bin 888 Cabernet Sauvignon (Margaret River) <i>Gold medal</i></b>	23
<b>*94/100</b> Our Brygon Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon has a fragrant bouquet of blackcurrent, blackberries and ripened plums blending into freshly ground coffee beans. Tinges of chocolate introduce a palate of soft cassis and espresso with a lengthy finish.	
<i>Quadrant Cabernet Sauvignon (Coonawarra South Australia)</i>	22
