Since 2006 the **NSW Maritime Recreational Boating Safety Course (BSC)** has been compulsory for all persons wishing to obtain their General Boat Licence from NSW Maritime. On June 1<sup>st</sup> 2009 it also became a compulsory requirement to undertake **'Practical' Boat Licence Training (BLT)**.

The NSW Maritime Recreational Boating Licence can be obtained by:

1. Enrolling in the All Hands on Deck Recreational Boating Course
2. Studying the NSW Maritime Boating Handbook
3. Checking your progress with our online assessments
4. Attending a 5 hour Boat Safety Course (BSC) and Boat Licence Training (BLT) session
5. Undertaking and successfully completing a written assessment

On successful completion of the course a Certificate of Course Completion is issued which is recognised by NSW Maritime for the issue of a General Boat Licence.

The course covers the areas listed below in accordance with the Recreational Outdoor Training Package SRO03:
