Seasonal Handy Hints and Tips;

Pest and Diseases

With the warm weather fast approaching, pests and diseases can multiply rapidly. Aphids breed especially fast so it is important to keep on top of these pests NOW.

Plan for the Holidays

December and January are generally the holiday months, and it is better to prepare the garden before going away as you don't want to come home to a jungle or worse a "dead and lifeless" garden, so make sure you are organised.

Ponds

Top your pond in hot weather as water can evaporate in ponds at quite an alarming rate during the hot spells. Keep an eye on your fish because if the water is still and level drops they may be starved of oxygen.

You can install a small water feature that will keep the water moving and the oxygen level high.



If your pond needs a refurbishment/clean out please let us know and we can discuss this option and give you a quote to suit your requirements.

Shrubs growing in containers.

In the warm weather they need to be regularly watered, you can have an automated watering system set up for your container plants. In very hot weather some of your plants may require twice a day watering.

Don't forget the fertilising and feed once a week with a high-potash fertiliser. Handy hint if going away, bring your plants into a shaded area and have a family member or neighbour check and water them whilst you are away.

Lavender – a favourite, this is the time of year to cut your lavender for drying. Keeping up a light prune on your lavender keeps the flowering lasting for quite some time, at the same time keeps your shape so the lavender doesn't get to big or woody.
