Hi, my name is Felicia TELEUCA. I am a professional tailor and teacher of sewing since 2006.

I have experience in women's garments, pattern-making, and grading. I started a fashion services business in 2010 and since I have successfully developed several services for fashion professionals and private persons across Europe.

Since 2011 I did contract work for well-known fashion houses in Belgium, France, and the Netherlands, where I learned a wide range of pattern-making, grading, sample-making, and haute-couture tailoring techniques. Occasionally, I have classes in sewing, design, and patterning for my private clients.

I love to teach my students the best sewing construction and neatening methods to use and how to achieve quality garments that look professional and fit well.

I try to approach teaching sewing differently than the way I learned. For me sewing isn't about obeying rules, I talk about sewing the way I experience it - sewing is about creative expression and a sewing machine is a really effective tool to do it with.

Of course, everything starts at your level.

I have had students of all levels from beginner to advanced and some professionals too.

I could adapt my class to function with your project. I have had advanced students which wanted to sew their own wedding dresses. I trained a professional seamstress with haute couture sewing techniques.

Course content

During beginner class, I teach:

- how a sewing machine works,
- how to wind and insert the bobbin,
- how to thread the machine,
- how to change the presser foot and insert a new needle,
- how to control the stitch length and width, and
- what the most useful stitches are.
- We talk about basic maintenance and essential sewing supplies.
- Finally, we sew a drawstring bag while
- talking about how to shop for fabric,
- how to measure,
- how to cut, lay and mark fabrics,
- how to press, pin, and other basics.

Subjects Taught - Sewing

Levels Taught: Beginner – Face to face or Online

- Learn the fundamentals of sewing in this beginner's online sewing course that offers flexibility, and self-paced learning and includes all of the fabric and tools that you need to get started.
- This beginner's online sewing course is tailored for people wanting to learn to sew at home, without any time pressure.
