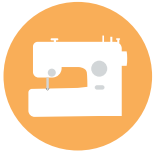

Mender's Sewing Machine Service

from **\$90**

A simple sewing machine that has no computerized components, and your buttonhole is a 4-step. Your bobbin is tucked behind a drop-down cover at the front and it can't be seen through the needle plate.



All-Rounder's Sewing Machine Service

from **\$120**

A standard sized machine, with or without computerized stitch selection, and you have a 1-step buttonhole. Your bobbin is most often visible through a plastic cover in the needle-plate, and you might have some beautiful decorative stitches and alphabets.



Quilter's Sewing Machine Service

from **\$140**

Your machine is bigger than the average, with a wider sewing space, and extra quilter's favourite functions. Your bobbin is most often visible through a plastic cover in the needle-plate, and your LCD screen is larger and often a touch screen.



Embroiderer's Sewing Machine Service

from **\$165**

The perfect trio – an All-Rounder, PLUS a Quilter, PLUS Embroidery functions. Your machine will have an embroidery arm, and an embroidery hoop, and uses memory cards or a USB stick to load designs



Seam-Stitcher's Overlocker Service

from **\$135**

You might also hear this one called a SERGER, your overlocker is 3 or 4 threads and can only stitch seams, neatly trimming fabric as you go.



Dressmaker's Overlocker Service

from **\$165**

Looks like an overlocker, but with an extra spool of thread, yours is a 5 thread coversitch and overlocker combination machine that can sew seams and then chain-stitch stretch fabric hems



Finisher's Coverstitch Machine Service

from **\$140**

A side-kick to your overlocker, your coverstitch machine can only do chain stitch and hemming, and has no cutting blades.



Just Embroiderer's Machine Service

from **\$140**

Looks like an Embroiderer's Sewing Machine, but this one doesn't do any sewing other than embroidery in the hoop. Typically, yours has no foot control, and uses memory cards or a USB stick to load designs.



Maybe a Tweak? Inspect and Quote

from **\$25**

Had a little hic-cup, but you don't think that you need a service? Book your machine in for an inspection and estimate to fix. Once you give the go-ahead, your booking fee will come off your finished bill. This also includes insurance quotes.

A **\$25** deposit is payable upon booking, and turn-around is generally 5 days. Services are priced 'from' as some additional repair work maybe needed for your machine. We allow a window of up to \$30 to be added to service pricing for discovered work or parts required, and we will contact you should your service exceeds this.
