Site Profiling / Auditing

Planning Structure

YOUR emergency response planning is adapted to your operational and resource capabilities. This includes designing and establishing the required emergency roles and responsibilities to be site specific which can be utilised with your internal Disaster Recovery and / or Business Continuity Planning.

Documentation

Emergency / Incident Training

EMERGENCY TRAINING SERVICES

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Every workplace is unique and requires emergency training to suit! WAem adapts training to complement your workplace culture providing education presented in a friendly, interactive atmosphere combined with hands on knowledge. We provide training in the following main areas of emergency management and also offer customised training if required. Wherever possible training is best "on site", but off site training can be arranged.

Emergency Planning Committee

A vital part of your organisation is to have a proactive EPC (Emergency Planning Committee). Your committee's responsibility is to administer YOUR sites emergency management procedures. WA*em* provides training ensuring they have the confidence and are competent in satisfying the roles of the committee.

WA*em* can also assist in your EPC meetings. If support, combined with knowledge is required, we can Provides specialist input to assist in your planning.

> Chief Warden Training

Undoubtedly YOUR Chief Warden holds a critical role in co-ordinating a successful outcome to any incident that may occur and holds the lead as a voluntary position in the ECO. WAem provides your Chief Warden with "hands on" training to gain understanding and confidence in co-ordinating emergency response evacuations. This training is combined with full training and utilisation of site Emergency Warning Systems.

> Warden Training

As with the Chief Warden, YOUR Warden Team hold voluntary positions that are a vital part of the ECO. WA*em* provide training to YOUR Wardens to gain understanding and confidence to competently perform their tasks and responsibilities in emergency situations.

EWS / EWIS Training

An essential part of WA*em* training is to provide practical instruction in the use of the EWS (Emergency Warning System) and EWIS (Emergency Warning Intercommunication System) panels. YOUR Team will gain understanding and confidence in operating the EWS / EWIS for use in emergency situations.



EMERGENCY TRAINING SERVICES (Cont...)

Scenario Exercises

WA*em* provide scenario exercise training using desktop applications or tailored interactive sessions. The ECO are presented with hypothetical emergency situations designed for the team to interact, practicing emergency plans and procedures to achieve a suitable outcome. Scenario exercises are designed to be engaging and assist the ECO in further gaining knowledge and confidence for use in emergency situations.

Evacuation Exercises

WA*em* work with your ECO to co-ordinate and execute evacuation exercises. Under Australian Standard AS 3745 all sites must conduct at least one annual evacuation exercise involving all occupants of the building. We monitor and observe the ECO in every evacuation and at the completion a detailed debriefing session is held providing feedback on the effectiveness of the ECO and identifying any improvement actions.

Reports

At the completion of training WA*em* will provide you with a comprehensive report detailing attendance numbers, observations and any recommendations we believe need addressing.
