### Golf course & practice facilities

### The Bay Experience

**\$975 pa**

**No Entrance Fee**

The Bay Experience offers a great opportunity to familiarise yourself with golf at Glenelg before taking the next step in your membership journey.

A great range of member benefits are included without the commitment of a full membership.

Course access in this category is restricted to ten (10) rounds per membership year and is only available for a duration of two (2) years from the date of commencement.

Upon transfer to other membership categories, the applicable Entrance Fee will apply.

### Women's Try Golf

**\$1,218.45 pa**

**No Entrance Fee**

Women's Try Golf membership is designed to encourage greater participation of women in the game of golf and to assist in the development of female golfers to prepare for long term membership opportunities at Glenelg Golf Club.

Membership in this category is restricted to two (2) years from the date of commencement.

Upon transfer to other membership categories, the applicable Entrance Fee will apply.

### Casual

**\$2,343.45 pa**

**\$1,875 Entrance Fee**

Casual membership provides a great introduction to club golf without the commitment of traditional membership options.

Casual members have access to the course at all times other than Wednesdays, Saturdays, Sunday mornings and Tuesday mornings paying the applicable green fee.

Transfer options exist for those wanting to progress to traditional membership options in the future.

The Entrance Fee must be paid upfront to be accepted as a Casual member.

### Provisional

**\$3,843.45 pa**

**\$7,500 Entrance Fee**

Provisional membership is the first step towards becoming a Full member of the Club and is open to any person over the age of 24.

Playing rights apply every day, excluding Saturday mornings.

When vacancies arise in the Full membership category, Provisional members are offered the opportunity to transfer based on length of membership.

The Entrance Fee can be paid upfront (15% discount), over 3 years or over 5 years (10% admin fee).

### Intermediate (18-24)

**\$1,594.45 pa**

**\$2,250 Entrance Fee**

Intermediate membership is available to anyone from 18 to 24 years of age.

Upon attaining the age of 25, Intermediate members are automatically transferred to Provisional or Full membership.

Some playing restrictions apply depending on your handicap.\*

An Intermediate member may pay the Entrance Fee upfront, or in equal instalments provided the entire Fee is paid by age 25.

### Junior (under 18)

**\$608.25 pa**

**\$1,875 Entrance Fee**

Junior membership is available to boys and girls under the age of 18.

We have an active junior development program providing a structured pathway for juniors to learn and improve their golf.

Junior members automatically transfer to Intermediate membership at the age of 18.

No part of the Entrance Fee must be paid in a Junior's first year of membership. Half of the Fee must be paid by age 21 with the remainder to be paid by age 25.
