



# New Membership & New Studentship Application Information 2010/2011

Please make sure the form on the reverse side is filled in completely and signed appropriately. The form must be accompanied by two separate payments, one for each organisation, unless paying by credit card. When **RENEWING** memberships, other than any special Concessions, the instructor's authorisation is not required and the application may be completed online at [www.aikido.org.au](http://www.aikido.org.au).

### Notes for Applicant

1. Fill in the Personal Details section on the form. This must include your current address; as required by law for Association members and is required for Personal Accident insurance.
2. Work out the correct pro-rata fees from the tables below. If you are claiming student, concession, junior or special fees, you must have the authorisation signed by your Area Representative or a senior instructor at your main Dojo. You will not be eligible for a reduction in fees unless this authorisation is signed. See reverse side for payment details.
3. Fill in and sign the Declaration on the form. Return the form with the fees to your Instructor for signing off and acceptance.
4. A student record book and membership cards will be issued. They will either be mailed to you or your instructor, depending on the choice made on the form. Retain the bottom part of the form as proof of payments until you receive them. *These are not issued to interim students.*

### Notes for Instructor

1. Check the information on the form and collect the payments and fill in the receipt and sign in indicated places.
2. Tear off the bottom section and present it to the applicant as a record of membership application. When interim students take out a full membership please send in a new form. Advise new members of how they will receive their Student Record Book and membership cards.
3. Return the form with the payment to the National Registrar immediately. When collecting interim fees send the form and money immediately. Please make it very clear on the form what type of membership has been paid.
4. If the Student Record Book is forwarded to you from the National Registrar, present it to the student.

### Insurance Cover

Aiki Kai (Australia) provides for all its trainees to be insured and currently carries two types of insurance cover.

1. To cover the possibility of a court action, your membership of Aiki Kai (Australia) may provide Legal Liability insurance for non-intentional injury if successfully sued by another student.

### Table of Membership/Studentship Types and Fees for the July 2010 - June 2011 Year

**Family:** This fee is for any family group which resides at the same address. To calculate the family fee, total the three most expensive individual membership fees (up to a maximum of three members). The family fee is 80% of that total – but not more than the maximum total yearly fee of \$140.00, see the pro-rata table below.

**Student & Concession:** The student/concession fee applies to members who are full time students or receiving Government assistance entitling them to a Health Benefits Card.

**Junior:** The junior fee applies to students aged up to 16 years.

**Special:** This applies to existing members (in any membership category) who move to a location where regular training is difficult. The state Area Representative has the discretion to waive up to 80% of the normal membership fee.
