New smoke alarm legislation comes into effect 1 January 2017.

All house hold smoke alarms will need to be photo electric and be interconnected.

The new legislation rolled by the Queensland government is a direct result of a number of horrific family tragedies that have occurred in recent times.

The new laws require each bedroom and hallway to have photoelectric interconnected smoke alarm as of the 1st January 2017.

- If your home was built or significantly renovated it must comply by the 1st January 2017.
- If you purchase or lease a home it must comply by the 1st January 2022.
- If you are an existing owner of a property and living in it you need to comply by 2027.
