Program Details

- 📖 Not all children find learning to read and write easy. Often small gaps are left in their learning that are not noticed until they are older. When these gaps are filled, there is frequently a huge advancement in their ability as well as their self-esteem.
- 📖 The Karinya Literacy Program is designed to fill these “gaps” and to cater for students with particular Language difficulties, i.e. Dyslexia, Short term memory and Auditory Processing Difficulties. The sessions are repetitive, tightly structured and are sequential, building on the information learnt in previous sessions.
- 📖 Individual needs highlighted in the assessment are addressed within the program and can be shared with the child’s teacher and other professionals.
- 📖 Results have shown 2-3 year increases in reading and spelling skills. Vocabulary and reading comprehension have also been found to improve. (See our book of referrals & recommendations.)

Program:-

- 1 session per week for 45 minutes
- Whole program extends over 20 weeks (School holidays excluded, unless requested.)
- Assessments will be made at the beginning of the program with a written report and recommendations for at home and for teachers.
- A short final assessment will be completed in the final session, to show progress made and to suggest any further recommendations for the future.

- **Initial full diagnostic Assessments** \$350
(Brief Assessment \$250 if already had IQ or speech assessment within the last 3 years.
\$150 if no report is needed.)
- **Program:-** Individual session \$70

- Final assessment completed in regular session.
- **Please note a fee of \$35 will be charged for absences, to cover costs of room rental and teachers, where there is late or no notification. There is no charge if your child is unwell.**

- 📖 Diagnostic Assessments and Individual programs are designed by Karen Perrin, (Bachelor of Education, Specializing in Remedial Literacy Development)
- 📖 All teachers are qualified, highly experienced teachers who may adapt the designed program to the ongoing needs of the student.
- 📖 Teachers will be available to discuss with parents and teachers the progress of the student whenever necessary. A regular session fee will be charged if a teacher is needed to attend for a meeting at the school.
