We can provide accredited Pilots, Police Escorts and arrange any additional permits i.e. Western Power and single trip oversize/mass permits outside of our 5.5m wide and high period permits.

We also have dangerous goods (including explosives) and controlled waste licensed trucks, trailers and drivers available to suit your requirements. We have retained the services of a suitably qualified Clean-Up Service Provider as per DOCEP requirements. Our Radiation Safety Officer is ready to help you with the movement of any radioactive substances.



Occupational Health & Safety

Blue Lightning Freight is committed to providing a high standard of safety and maintaining a healthy working environment as per the Occupational Safety and Health Act 1984. We operate under The Code of Practice - Fatigue Management for Commercial Vehicle Drivers.

Prior to employment all drivers must complete

1. Commercial Driver medical
2. Fatigue management training and assessment
3. Police clearance

Successful applicants complete additional load restraint training, site specific inductions and are allocated Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Our drivers are very familiar with different mine site OHS policies and procedures which are strictly adhered

too. Under our Fitness for Duty/Fatigue & Health Management Plan (FFD/HMP) drivers must be fit for work, are continually assessed and subject to random drug and alcohol screening. Blue Lightning Freight has a zero tolerance to alcohol and drugs in our workplace.

All drivers adhere to the FFD/HMP and complete trip sheets or log books to comply. Our own internal system is subject to an annual audit and complies with Worksafe Western Australia. Blue Lightning Freight Pty Ltd prides itself in providing a healthy and safe workplace for all employees and visitors. We recognise the importance of developing and maintaining safe work procedures and working conditions.

Fleet

We have a large range of vehicles available to suit your requirements including:

Each truck has a satellite tracking system installed allowing us to monitor and prioritise our fleet. The system also allows two way messaging, keeping us in constant communication with drivers Australia wide 24/7 even when out of mobile phone range. In the event of an emergency the operator can, with the press of a button, activate the emergency response system that links to management mobile phones, emails and computer

interface. The system forms an integral part of our Dangerous Goods and Controlled Waste emergency response and spill plans.

All our vehicles from 6 tonne and upwards are accredited by Main Roads WA and hold oversize period permits for all states and Territories in Australia. All our equipment is either owned or being purchased by us. Vehicle maintenance is carried out in our own modern workshop in Kewdale with preventative maintenance being our primary concern. We maintain our modern equipment to the highest standard ensuring we can deliver your freight on time, every time.
