- If possible, the operator is to park the machine on level ground or at the designated mobile equipment parking pad.
- Lower the bucket/blade/lines /bowl etc. to the ground and apply the park brake. Check the wheels of all mobile machinery to prevent movement.
- Turn off the mobile equipment and, if required, attach an "Out of Service" tag to the steering controls and battery isolator.
- Notify the repairer and/or site supervisor/manager of the problem.
- Repairer to support and/or pin raised bodies/cabins to prevent movement and articulation.
- Install articulation restraint pin in all articulated vehicles, e.g. front end loader, scrapers etc.
- Obtain personal isolation lock, lockout hasp and complete a Danger Tag or lockout register. (If the personal lock does not have your name on it.)
- If fitted, drain all air receivers and relieve hydraulic pressure through manipulation of the steering and/or hydraulic controls.
- The repairer(s) are required to isolate all Energy Sources (primary, electrical, pneumatic and hydraulic sources of energy) AND ensure that the machine is at zero energy potential prior to the installation of the lockout hasp and their personal isolation lock. Note: Some mobile equipment may not be fitted with a lockout point and/or some tasks may require energy sources to remain available. In these cases the task must be risk assessed and the specific risk controls implemented prior to the commencement of work.
- Complete the repairs.
- Remove your personal isolation lock, lockout hasp and the checks and/or pins.
- After testing the equipment, remove the "Out of Service" tag, inform the Operator and the site supervisor/manager that the machine is ready for use.
- Never remove or interfere with another persons isolation lock.
- Everyone working on the mobile equipment will install their personal isolation lock to the relevant point(s) required for the identified task.
- Do not attempt to start mobile equipment if someone has it locked out.
